Notes

Note A. The Financial Supervision Commission has the power to refuse any name that in its opinion is undesirable or impose conditions to the use of a name to ensure that it is not undesirable (see Section 16 of the Registration of Business Names Act, 1918).

Note B. This statement must in all cases be signed either:

- (a) by all the individuals who are partners and by a director or the secretary of each corporation and in the case of a limited liability company, by a manager or member which is a partner, or
- (b) (1) by some individual who is a partner, or
(2) by a director or the secretary of some corporation, or in the case of a limited liability company a manager or member, which is a partner; and in either of the cases (b) (1) and (2) must be verified by a statutory declaration made by the signatory, and must be sent by post or delivered to PO Box 345, Companies Registry, Finch Hill House, Bucks Road, Douglas, Isle of Man IM99 2QS, within one month of commencing to carry on such business.

Failure, without reasonable excuse, to furnish the required statement of particulars within the time specified will, in addition to any disability imposed by the Act, entail liability on conviction to a fine not exceeding £5000; any statement which contains any matter which is false in any material particular to the knowledge of any person signing it will entail liability on conviction to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to a fine not exceeding £5000, or to both such imprisonment and fine.

Where the firm applying for registration carries on the business wholly or mainly as nominee or trustee of or for another person or other persons or a corporation or acts as general agent for any foreign firm, the additional particulars specified in the Form BN2A must also be furnished on that form and sent by post or delivered to the Companies Registry in the manner and within the time before specified.

Note C. Section 2 of the Act provides as follows:

“In the case of a peer or person usually known by a British title different from his surname, the title by which he is known shall be substituted in this Act for his surname.”

Note D. “References in this Act to a former first name or surname shall not, in the case of natural-born British subjects, include a former first name or surname where that name or surname has been changed or disused before the person bearing the name has attained the age of eighteen years, but, in the case of a woman who has been married, shall include the name or surname by which she was known previous to the marriage.”
